### Purpose

We are seeking to employ a lecturer in finance who will undertake teaching and scholarship in a range of undergraduate and postgraduate modules. Applicants should have experience of teaching subjects such as corporate finance and risk management in a higher education setting.

### Main duties and responsibilities

- Teach, assess and provide developmental feedback to undergraduate and postgraduate students in a range of modules.
- Review and update module content and materials, applying knowledge gained from relevant research and scholarship, together with insights gained from module evaluations and peer evaluations.
- Engage with new developments in teaching and learning, this includes working towards Fellowship of Advance HE if not already achieved.
- Support students' academic and professional development, particularly as an academic tutor
- Work with colleagues to enhance the collegial and supportive working environment in the ICMA Centre. This includes, but is not limited to attendance at programme and department meetings and student-facing events such as departmental welcomes and graduation.
- Undertake outreach activities such as giving presentations at open and visit days.
